



A LOOK BACK AT 15 YEARS OF ADVOCACY ON HEALTH FOR ALL!

In 2001, Global Health Advocates - then known as the "Massive Effort Campaign" - was launched to support the fight against malaria, tuberculosis and HIV/AIDS. Global Health Advocates was officially created in 2005. In 2008, the organisation was registered in France and joined the ACTION international network.

DELEGATION

Global Health Advocates organises its first parliamentary delegation in Burkina Faso, focusing on the fight against tuberculosis and management of TB/HIV co-infection.

COORDINATION

Global Health Advocates opens an office in Brussels and becomes the coordinator of the TB Europe Coalition - informal at first, the coalition is officially registered in 2018.

INNOVATION

Global Health Advocates becomes co-host of the Secretariat of the European Parliament Working Group on Innovation, Access to Medicines and Poverty-Related Diseases.

NUTRITION

Global Health Advocates begins its advocacy work on the topic of child malnutrition in the run up to the first Nutrition for Growth (N4G) summit in London.

COALITION

Global Health Advocates launches the French "Collectif Santé Mondiale", bringing together 11 NGOs, defending and promoting global health financing in France.

Global Health Advocates releases the report "Misplaced Trust: diverting aid to stop migration", which is presented to the European Parliament's Development Committee.

Global Health Advocates launches the "Paris Appeal" to combat maternal and child mortality under the patronage of Paris' mayor, Anne Hidalgo.

SOLIDARITY

Global Health Advocates actively supports the implementation of a Financial Transaction Tax in France, providing an innovative way of funding international development and global health.

REPLENISHMENT

Global Health Advocates plays a leading role in the largest replenishment of the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria to date, organised under the leadership of President Emmanuel Macron.

DEVELOPMENT

Global Health Advocates launches the "What if we started with basic needs?" campaign in partnership with several other CSOs to ensure that essential social services are prioritised in France's Official Development Assistance.

TRANSPARENCY

Global Health Advocates leads the #HealthyPrices campaign for greater EU transparency of medical R&D and better access to medicines in Europe and around the world.

PARTNERSHIP

Global Health Advocates strengthens the voice of francophone actors within the ACTION network by promoting the arrival of a new member, the Côte d'Ivoire-based NGO: ASAPSU.

EQUITY

Global Health Advocates facilitates a meeting between President Emmanuel Macron and several French NGOs committed to ensuring equitable access to COVID-19 tools and to strengthening actions in favour of SRHR.

REPRESENTATION

Global Health Advocates represents the "Collectif Santé Mondiale" at the official launch of France's Global Health Strategy 2023-2027, alongside 3 Ministers and the French Global Health Ambassador.

PRIORISATION

Global Health Advocates successfully campaigns to ensure equitable access to healthcare is a priority of the European Union-African Union summit.
