


EU ODA DEDICATED TO HEALTH IN 2022

Out of the €31,2 billion allocated to ODA, €1.6 billion goes to health. This represents 5% of all EU ODA and a decrease compared to 2021, when health accounted for 7,9% of EU ODA.




Compared with G7 countries, the EU has the lowest share of ODA dedicated to health.

The sharp increase of health ODA in 2021 is mainly due to the Covid-19 response. In 2022, health ODA fell once more, returning to pre-pandemic levels.



While the majority of EU ODA is channeled bilaterally, a larger share of EU health ODA is in fact channeled multilaterally than bilaterally. However, despite representing a much higher percentage of the total, multilaterally channeled health ODA is rather similar in volume to that channeled bilaterally (985,15 vs 601,35).
